MARCIA W. DORT STRING SCHOLARSHIP AUDITION

When: Thursday, November 19, 2020 6:00 – 9:00 PM

Eligibility: Any exceptionally talented violin, viola, cello or bass player who is a member of the Flint Youth String Orchestra, Flint Youth Philharmonia or Flint Youth Symphony (9th – through 12th grade) and who will not have graduated from high school by May 31, 2021 may audition. Applicants may audition only on the instrument they play in their large ensemble and must be taking music lessons with an FSPA instructor.

Audition

- Requirements:
- Two (2) solos of contrasting styles & composers, one memorized *
 - Piano accompaniment is required for the audition
 - Interview
 - There must be a minimum of 3 applicants to have the audition
- * The performance portion of the audition will not exceed 10 minutes. The adjudicator may cut off your pieces if the length totals more than 10 minutes.

Scholarship: To be used for instrument, instrument repairs, sheet music, strings, case, bow, recordings, and additional music lessons. The scholarship may not be used for summer camp study. (Effective Nov. 23, 2020 – Jan., 30, 2021)

The recipient and parent will submit a draft proposal to the FSPA director, who will present it to the trustees for approval. In addition, the scholarship recipient must perform a solo recital prior to January 31, 2021.
