



## Allan & Barbara Walters Education Fund Scholarship Audition

**When:** Wednesday, November 16, 2022 6:00pm—9:00pm

**Eligibility:** Any 9<sup>th</sup>—12<sup>th</sup> grade flute player who is a member of the Flint Youth Philharmonia, Flint Youth Wind Ensemble, or Flint Youth Symphony who will not have graduated from high school by May 31, 2023. Applicant’s tuition must be paid in full for the current term to eligible. Applicants may audition only if they play the flute in their large ensemble and must currently be taking lessons with an FSPA instructor.

**Audition Requirements:**

- Two (2) solo of contrasting styles & composers, one memorized\*
- Piano accompaniment is required for the audition
- Interview
- There must be a minimum of three (3) applicants to have the audition.

*\* The performance portion of the audition will not exceed 10 minutes. The adjudicator may cut you off at any time.*

**Scholarship:** To be used for instrument, instrument repairs, sheet music, case, recordings, and additional music lessons. The scholarship may not be used for summer camp study. (Effective Nov. 17, 2022 — Jan. 30, 2023).

The recipient and parent will submit a draft proposal to the FSPA Director, who will present it to the Trustees for approval. In addition, the scholarship recipient must perform a solo recital prior to Feb. 3, 2023.
