MUSIC LESSON MERIT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION
2018/2019

Students seeking a Music Lesson Merit Scholarship are required to:

1. Be a current FSPA student enrolled in a full nine week term of music lessons. Applicants must have completed the previous full term of FSPA music lessons to qualify. Applicants may audition only on the instrument they study at the Flint School of Performing Arts.
2. Complete and return this application to the FSPA Office **no later than 5:00 PM, for the current semester. Applications will NOT be accepted by fax.** Summer Semester – May 18, 2018; Fall Semester – September 21, 2018; Winter Semester – January 18, 2019.
3. Attend an audition. Auditions are scheduled for Saturday, June 2, 2018; Friday, October 12 & Saturday, October 13, 2018; Friday, February 8 & Saturday, February 9, 2019. Your audition should consist of a prepared portion of a solo. **If you have previously performed a piece that was awarded a scholarship, you must select a new piece.** Your 4 minute audition starts once you walk into the audition room and have been introduced to the Adjudicators. The Adjudicators may interrupt your piece at the 4 minute point.

Auditions are required to be eligible for the scholarship. If you need a specific audition time, please note it at the **bottom of this application**. If possible, we will accommodate your request. If you need an accompanist, please pick up a *How to Find an Accompanist* information sheet at the office. You may apply for help paying for an accompanist if needed through the Music Support Fund. You will be notified of your assigned audition time by **E-MAIL**. Please provide your e-mail address on this form.

4. Scholarship awards are determined solely by the adjudicators at the time of the audition. Awards range from \$40 - \$800 (see pg. 2 for details). Award notification is by **E-MAIL**.
5. Members of the Dort Honors String Quartet, FSPA Honors String Quartet or the Shand Honors Flute Quartet are ineligible to audition for a merit scholarship for fall & winter semesters.
